DAREDEVIL

More Than Ready - Chasethewildwind, by Forty Niner 2012 CH | 16.1 Hands

Daredevil is a history-making son of a history-making sire. Winner of the Champagne Stakes (G1), Daredevil is a son of More Than Ready, a three-time leading sire of two-year-olds and sire of more than 200 individual stakes winners. Daredevil himself is the only stallion to sire a Kentucky Oaks (G1) winner and a Preakness Stakes (G1) winner in his first crop.

The cross with mares by A.P. Indy and his sons is becoming a very important one for Daredevil. His Kentucky Oaks (G1) heroine, Shedaresthedevil is out of a mare by Congrats, himself a brother to Flatter (sire of Flat Out and Upstart) and he also has 2022 two-year-old stakes winner Vedareo out of a mare by Mineshaft (sire of Discreetly Mine and Dialed In) and stakes winner He'smyhoneybadger out of a mare by Majestic Warrior, as well as stakes winner Daring Devil out of a mare by A.P. Indy himself. Congrats and Mineshaft are bred on the A.P. Indy/Mr. Prospector cross, as are Malibu Moon, Pulpit and Girolamo. Pulpit is the sire of the likes of Sky Mesa and Tapit (himself sire of Constitution, Frosted, Cupid, Tonalist, Trappe Shot, Tapiture and Tapizar). It would also be worth considering mares by A.P. Indy sons Bernardini (sire of Stay Thirsty and To Honor and Serve), Take Charge Indy and Jump Start.


One the most proflic crosses for More Than Ready and his sons has been with Danzig line mares, which has provided more than 80 stakes winners, 13 Grade 1. Daredevil is no exception having sired stakes winner Deviant out of a mare by Monashee Mountain. Many of the standouts on the More Than Ready/Danzig cross are through mares by Danehill and his sons, but of stallions that have stood in the U.S. we can note the cross succeeding through daughters of Anabaa, Belong to Me, Hard Spun, Langfuhr, Lure, Pine Bluff, Polish Numbers, U S Ranger, War Chant and War Front (sire of The Factor, Air Force Blue, Data Link, Declaration of War, Hit It A Bomb and Summer Front). Mares by Exchange Rate might also work.

Danzig is a son of Northern Dancer, and not surprisingly, Daredevil has combined successfully with other branches of male lines descending from that great patriarch, most notably through his daughter Swiss Skydiver, who became one of very few distaffers to defeat a male Horse of the Year in head-to-head competition when outdueling Authentic in the Preakness Stakes (G1). She is out of a mare by Johannesburg (sire of Scat Daddy) from the Storm Cat line. Johannesburg is by Hennessy, and there are also More Than Ready line stakes winners out of mares by Hennessy sons Henny Hughes and Cactus Ridge. Daredevil is also sire of stakes winner Indian Lake out of a mare by Storm Cat son, Stormy Atlantic. On the broader cross, we can also note Grade 1 winners out of mares by Forestry (sire of Discreet Cat and Shackleford), Giant's Causeway (sire of Not This Time, Eskendereya, Cowboy Cal and First Samurai, and a brother to Freud), and Harlan's Holiday (sire of Into Mischief – who has crossed well with this family – Majesticperfection and Shanghai Bobby). Other Storm Cat sons to appear as broodmare sires of More Than Ready-line stakes winners are Black Minnaloushe, Cat Thief, Forest Wildcat (sire of Wildcat Heir), Pure Prize, Sir Cat (who would be very interesting here), Storm Boot and Tale of the Cat (sire of Lion Heart and Tale of Ekati; grandsire of Uncaptured, Kantharos and Girvin). Other possibilities are Bernstein and Bluegrass Cat – both very interesting here – and Yankee Gentleman.

From another branch of Northern Dancer, Daredevil has the multiple stakes winning and Grade 1-placed Esplanande out of a mare by Dixie Union (sire of Union Rags), a son of Dixieland Band.

Daredevil has stakes winner Haengbok Wangja out of a mare by Broken Vow, a son of Unbridled. More Than Ready did very well with mares by another Unbridled son, Unbridled's Song, and there is also a stakes winner out of a mare Unbridled son, Empire Maker (sire

of Pioneerof the Nile and Bodemeister; grandsire of American Pharoah — who has crossed very well with mares by More Than Ready — Classic Empire and Cairo Prince). Unbridled is a Fappiano-line horse, and there is a More Than Ready Grade 1 winner out of a mare by Fappiano son Quiet American (grandsire of Midnight Lute) and the Candy Ride branch of that line could also work here.

Fappiano is a Mr. Prospector-line stallion and from other branches of Mr. Prospector we can note More Than Ready and his sons succeeding with Gone West through Elusive Quality (sire of Quality Road), Grand Slam, Mr. Greeley and Speightstown (sire of Munnings), Kingmambo and his son Lemon Drop Kid, and Street Cry (sire of Street Sense and Street Boss).
